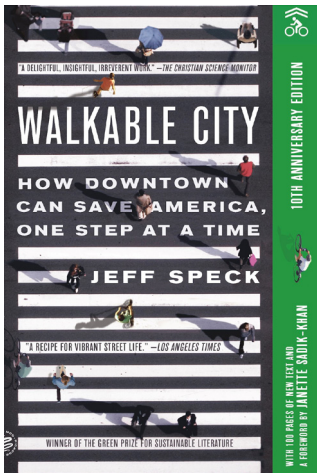




Great Streets Downtown Hyannis: A Walkable Heart for Cape Cod

The *Walkable City* author will be speaking about his experience in transforming cities around the world and what this means for reimagining the downtown Hyannis street network and streetscape in the coming months.

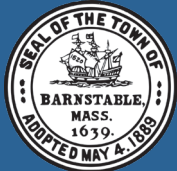
The Town is hosting this event to kick off a project to develop a new vision for Main Street and the streets nearby. This might include concepts such as:
