This year's Guest Speaker is Colonel Walter Watson, USMC (Ret). The program will conclude with the laying of the wreaths and the Benediction.

Everyone will be invited to attend the 7th Annual Veterans Town Hall in the James H. Crocker, Jr. Hearing Room, Barnstable Town Hall, 2nd Floor, 367 Main Street, Hyannis. The event features seven (7) ten-minute testimonies of Combat Veterans.

Please join this community event hosted by the Town of Barnstable and the Cape & Islands Veterans Outreach Center: an opportunity to listen respectfully and demonstrate your interest genuinely. This is a solemn and non-political event. There is no question and answer period; no debate on the merits or justifications of war; no recrimination or accusations.
